Cattle, Sheep and Goats Stabling & Stallage:

Cattle, Sheep and Goats will be accommodated in covered enclosures suitable for the purpose, and will be admitted from Friday preceding the show. In addition to the entry fee, pens cost an extra £14 per pen for sheep exhibited both days, £10 per pen for sheep exhibited for 1 day only and £6 per pen for goats. However, sheep and goats from the same exhibitor can share pens on a breed specific basis (please ensure you indicate number of pens required on entry form).
